Newark-on-Trent

The historic market town of Newark-on-Trent is situated within easy distance for commuters from Nottingham, Lincoln and Grantham. It has good links with the UK transport network via the East Coast Main line high speed train services to London and the North. It is situated where the A1, A46 and A17 road network meets.

Newark-on-Trent has a lovely cobbled market place overlooked by the elegant Georgian Town Hall housing the Town Treasures and Art Gallery. Walking around the town you will notice a mixture of beautiful buildings of both architectural and historical importance. The imposing ruins of the 12th century Castle, the beautiful Parish Church, ornate Gilstrap Centre and nearby Air Museum all add to the town's attraction to visitors from both the UK and abroad.

Newark is positioned on the River Trent, which means you can enjoy a riverside walk or a relaxing river trip. The award-winning Riverside Park has played host to the Newark Festival, Newark on Water festival, Food Festival and the circus and fair when they come to town. Amble along the town lock and sensory garden, with its seated areas, piped clas- sical music, and a water feature which has been designed for people with visual impairments.

The town centre offers a good selection of local shops, award-winning restaurants and bars, all adding to your Newark experience. You can also catch up with the week's news with the Newark Advertiser.

National Health Service

Students studying in the UK may be entitled to the following services:

- Free consultation and treatment with a doctor (GP) who is qualified to diagnose and treat most illnesses
- Free consultation from a specialist doctor to whom your GP may refer you for more extensive treatment
- Free in-patient treatment in hospital
- Reduced cost in dental treatment, ophthalmic treatment and medication prescribed by a GP

Students applying for a visa to study in the UK, need to check the guidelines when accessing healthcare in the UK. Students may have to pay an Immigration health surcharge as part of their visa application fee.

IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT YOU REGISTER WITH A GP ON YOUR ARRIVAL IN NEWARK

If you become ill and require medication, your GP will give you a "prescription" - a small hand written certificate. You take this to a Chemist in exchange for medicine for which there will be a charge. You could, however, try and reclaim the cost of the prescription by completing an HC1 Application Form (obtainable from the Post Office).

To register for the National Health Service (NHS), you must first go to your nearest doctor's surgery. You must take your passport with you. There you will be able to register with both the doctors and the NHS. You will be given a form to complete and return. Within a few days you should receive a medical card in the post. You will need to produce this whenever you need treatment on the NHS

There are several things you should remember when visiting a doctor or dentist. Firstly, if you need to see a doctor or dentist, you must make an appointment and it is important to be punctual. When registering or visiting a dentist, make sure that he or she will accept NHS patients as private dentists will change much more.

NB: Any stay in an NHS hospital may be free.

How do I open an account?

Once you've decided on the type of account you want to open, you'll usually be asked to:

- Provide proof of identity:- you need to prove who you are and where you live
- Fill in an application form
- Pay some money into your account (however some banks let you do this later).

Proof of Your Identity*

Acceptable documents usually include your passport, driving licence, Residence Permit, ID card from work or letter confirming your state pension or other benefit.

Proof of Your Address*

Acceptable documents include recent gas, electricity or phone bill, water bill, council tax bill, driving licence, letter confirming you state pension or other benefit, income tax statement, motor/home insurance certificate or mail order statement.

* Other documents may be acceptable if you ask

You can't use the same document as proof of both your identity and address. If you don't have any suitable documents, contact the bank or building society - they can usually suggest other ways to prove who you are and where you live.

Students will also need to provide proof of student status - such as the letter of admission received from college or university.



Advice on Making Applications to Trusts

- 1. Ensure that you meet all the criteria before applying.
- 2. Address your application to a named person if possible
- 3. Check on application procedures e.g. whether an application form is needed and the time scales for processing
- 4. Include a clear statement of who you are and your objectives.
- 5. State clearly the purpose for which the funds are needed and the amount required
- 6. Provide proof of your financial circumstances
- 7. Keep it brief. Be clear concise and jargon-free. Limit it to no more than two pages, preferably word processed



From Northbound A1

Leave the A1 at the Newark southern exit onto the B6326. Continue on the B6326 (London Road) for 2.1 miles, until the traffic light junction with Sherwood Avenue.

Turn right onto Sherwood Avenue.

Continue onto Friary Road.

The College is located on the left hand side (see inset).

From A1 Southbound

Leave the A1 at the Newark exit for the A46/A17/B6166. At the roundabout at the end of the slip road, take the first exit onto the A46.

Pass over the A1 and at the next roundabout take the first exit onto the B6166.

Continue on the B6166 (Lincoln Road) until the traffic light junction with Queens Road.

Turn left onto Queens Road. Continue onto Sleaford Road. Turn right onto Friary Road.


The College is located on the right hand side (see inset).
